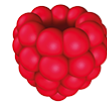

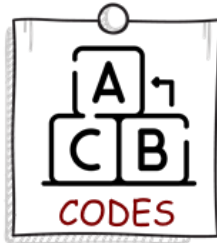


## Quiz / Multiple Choice

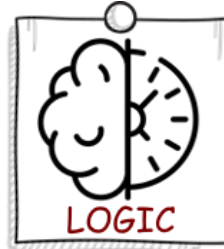


## Matching exercise

- Day of Epiphany



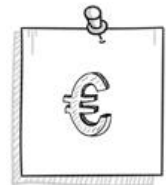
## Guess the answer
